Laws you must know:

-  Family Educational Rights Privacy Act (FERPA)
-  Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)
-  New York Education Law § 2-d and Part 121 of the regulations of the Commissioner of Education

What's required under Ed Law § 2-d and Part 121:

-  Districts *must* enter into a data protection agreement (DPA) when sharing student data with third party contractors (includes studies and research and audits (not OSC audits)).
-  Districts *must* share supplemental information about their data sharing (contracts) and it *must* be on their website.
