What comes next?

The first regionalization conversations, which focus on logistic packing the aims of the policy, and building a foundation for future collaboration, do not require data from the Strengths and Needs ToolTherefore, the deadline for holding these initial meetings remains November 1, 2024.

Subsequento completion of the Strengths and Needs Top India dissemination of data to help inform regional discussion an Interim Progress Report will drafted by the BOCES District Superintendent, shared with their component school district governance teams, and then transmitted to NYSED on or before April 1. 2025 Iter feedback the District Superintendent will submit a Regionalization Plan on or before October 1, 2025 deadlines, as set forth in the regulation, also remain unchanged.

Finally, as a reminder, the Regionalization regulations are still out for public comment, and we encourage your continued engagement in the process.
